1. Brief details of the event highlights: A three day long Faculty Development program was organised by CGC Landran from 2nd to 4th January, 2019. The Program was primarily premeditated to focus on Research Grants, Project funding and consultation for Academic institutes.

The program started with the inauguration session on 2nd January, 2019 followed by the program overview presented by Dr. Vishal B. Soni, Director Principal, CBSA.

The series started with the 1st session by Dr. M.L. Singla, Professor, FMS, Delhi. The objective of the session was to apprise the audience on building Research and consulting based culture within the institute.
