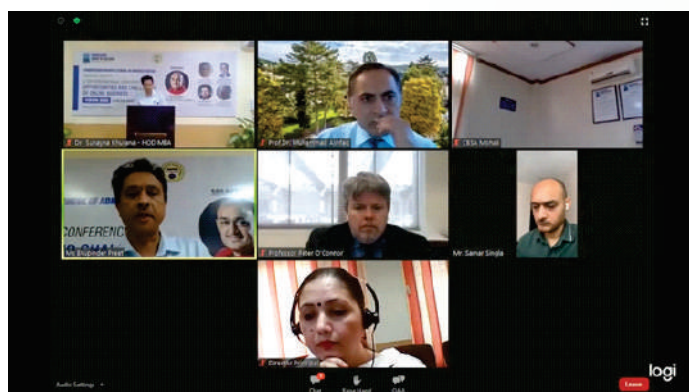
new normal in education. We are eagerly looking forward to meeting the students in the campus once the situation allows," said Chairman Satnam Singh Sandhu.

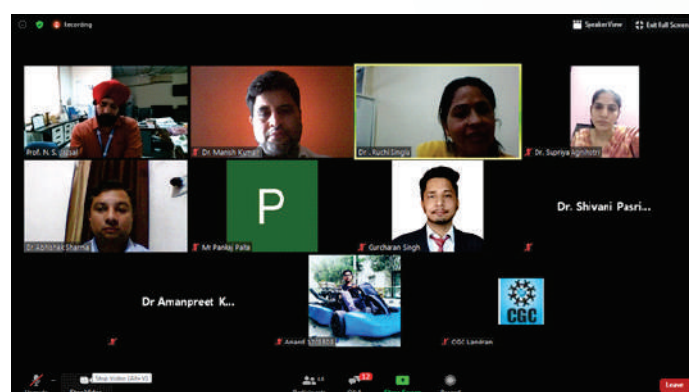
