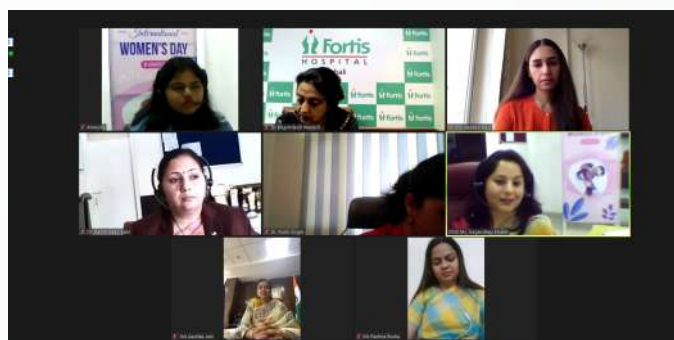
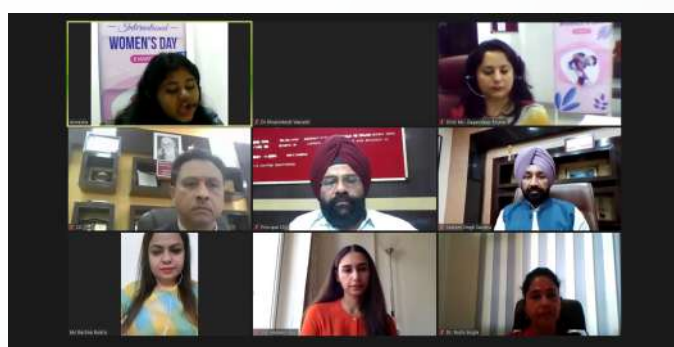

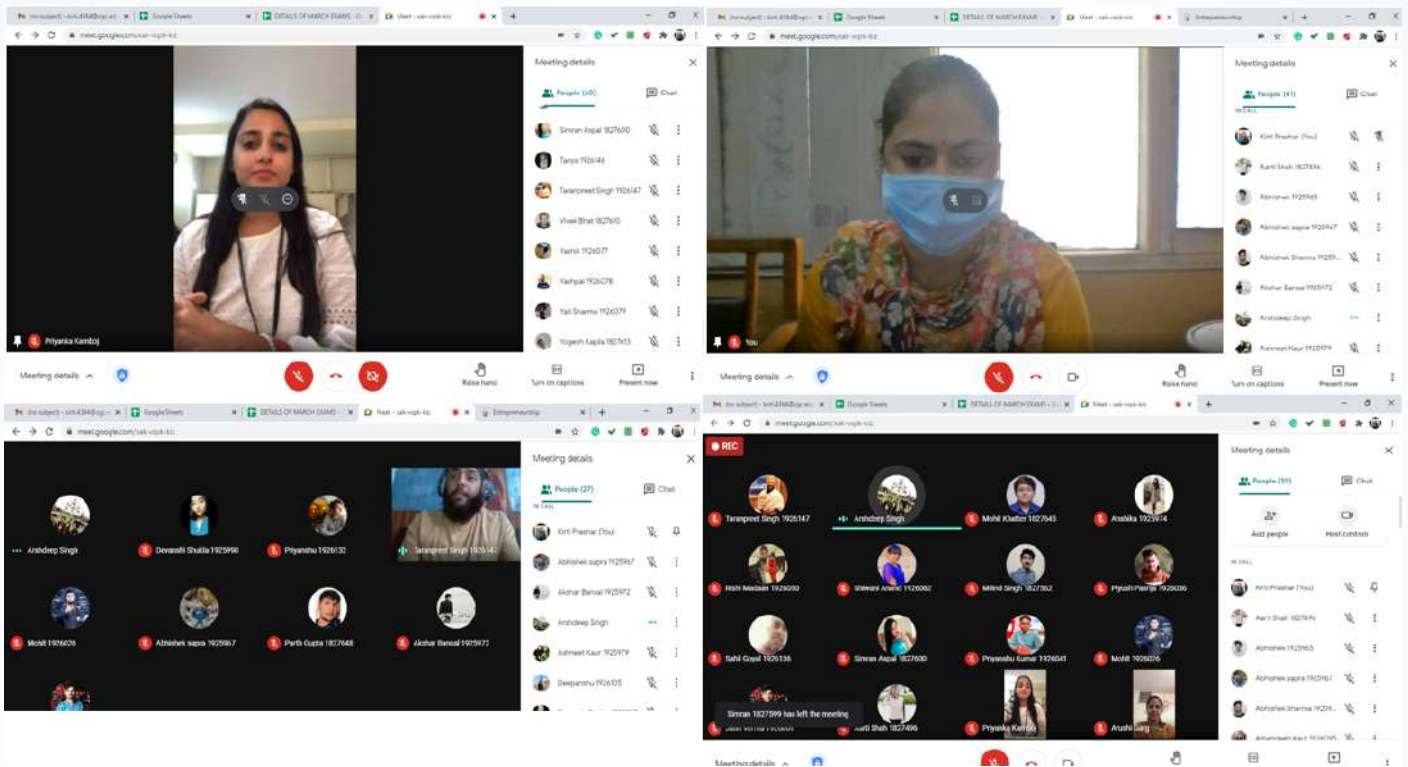




In today's time, youngsters are greatly inclined towards starting their ventures and become successful entrepreneurs.

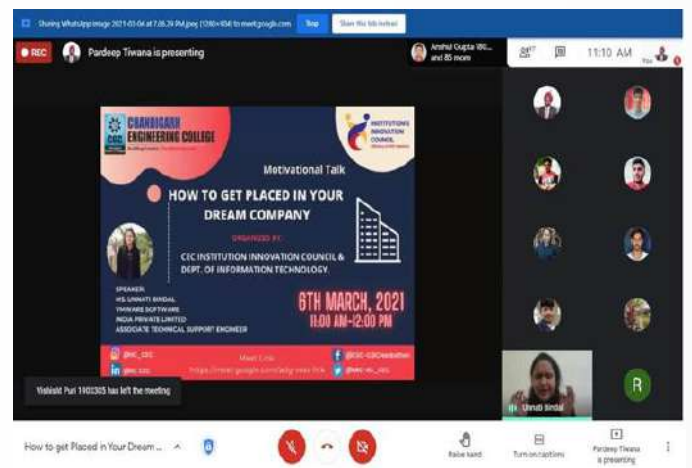
Thus, to let them understand the requirements for executing an idea into a successful business, our Department of BBA in association with IIC (Institution
