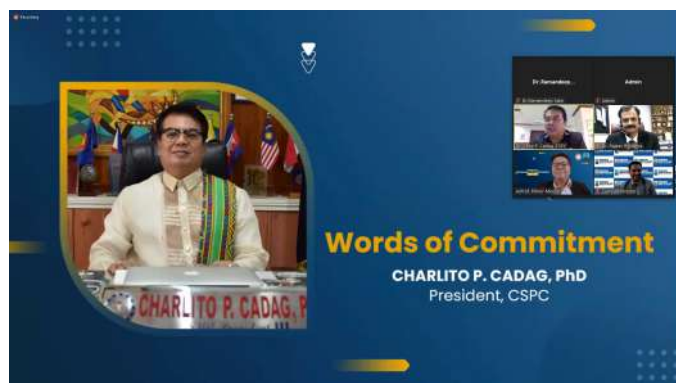
Homeopathy (AYUSH) organized a 1-week Yoga Camp. Students were encouraged to adapt yoga as a way of living to overcome stress and stay happy.
